Nina’s passion for helping players improve their tennis skills along with her soft skills, creativity and tennis technical knowledge makes her a valuable addition to EMTC pro team.

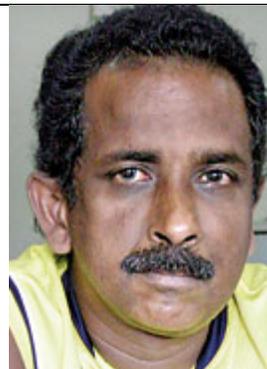
